Uncover the Hidden Kingdom of Wayanad

The untouched, raw beauty of Wayanad's forests is an invitation to be a spectator in nature's backyard. Pack your bags and spend your holidays in close quarters with the residents of UNESCO's eighth hottest hotspot - the Western Ghats; the unique ecosystem and climate conditions have made it a favourite spot for rare and endemic species.

Experience an enriching trek through thickets in the company of 45 species of mammals, 330 species of birds, over 55 species of reptiles and amphibians, and 170 species of butterflies, encountering rare sights in nature's own backyard.

The forest lodges of Wayanad Wild immerse you in a surreal experience, living and breathing alongside the residents of Lakkidi. While the morning air is filled with the chorus of rare birds endemic to the Western Ghats, the cover of night invites you to explore the hidden world of flora and fauna – inculcating a sense of curiosity and respect for nature.

The sights and sounds of the deciduous forest hang on your windowsill or rest on the balcony ledge while you sip your favourite drink – a thrilling experience for wildlife photographers, nature enthusiasts, or a family looking to bond in the midst of nature. Our naturalists will guide you through various activities and explorations, allowing you to experience some of the integral parts of the forest.

*This activity is not available during the monsoon season.

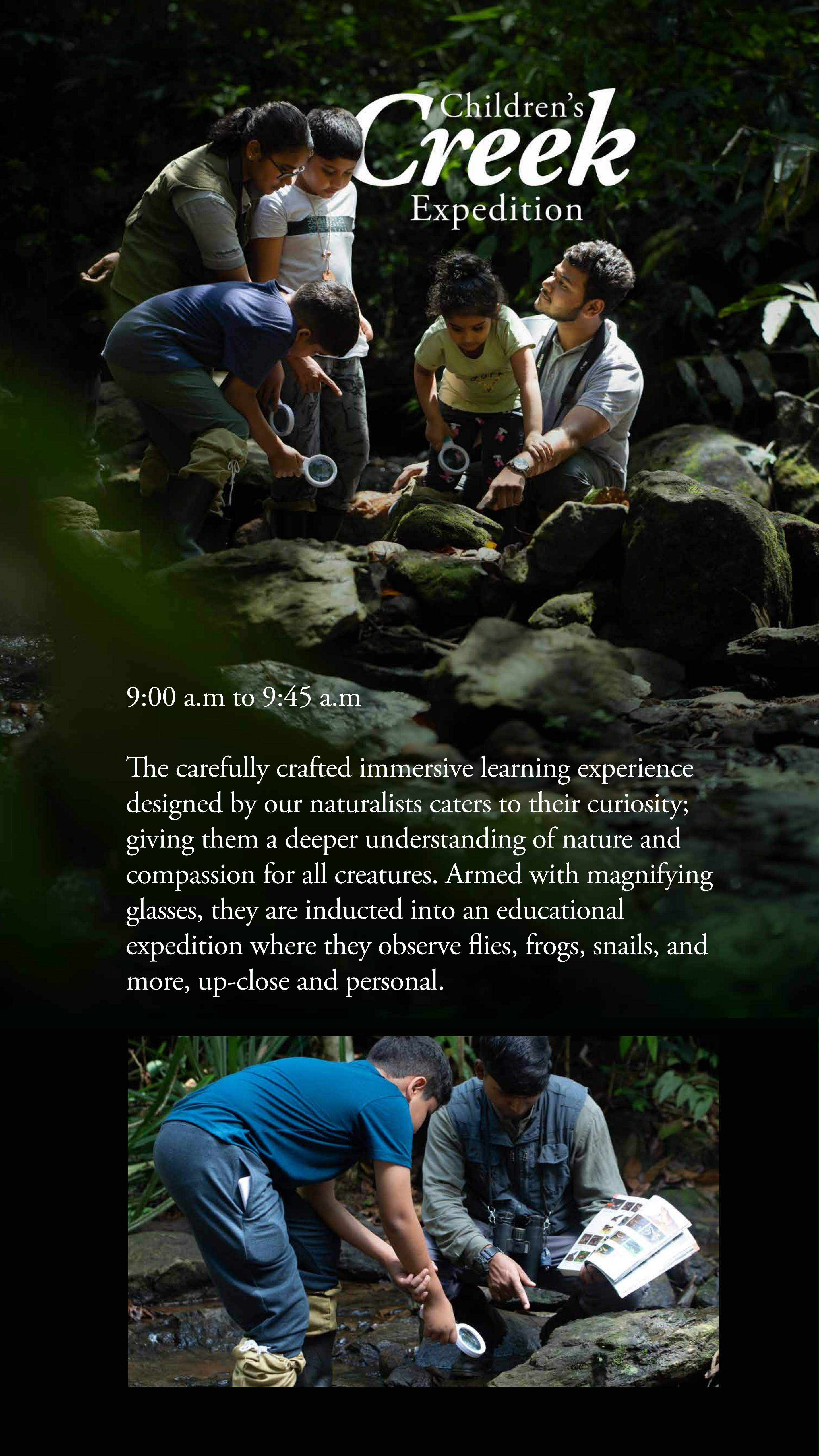

Explore the *Wild Hike*

7:00 a.m - 8:00 a.m

The tree-lined path at Wayanad Wild takes you through some of the undiscovered wonders of the rainforest. Our trained naturalists are well-versed with the ways of the wild and assist you in spotting the rare and endemic flora and fauna of Lakkidi.

Armed with magnifying glasses, they are inducted into an educational expedition where they observe flies, frogs, snails, and more, up-close and personal.

3:00 p.m - 4:30 p.m

Nocturnal *Nature* Discoveries

9:00 p.m - 10:00 p.m

Witness a different side of nature during our night expedition. Geared with flashlights, take a walk with our expert naturalists within the premises and observe the residents of the Western Ghats from a distance. Feel the thrill and excitement of discovering a plethora of creatures ranging from the Bush Frog to Porcupines and Brown Palm Civet to the Mouse Deer.

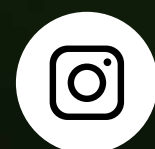
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
