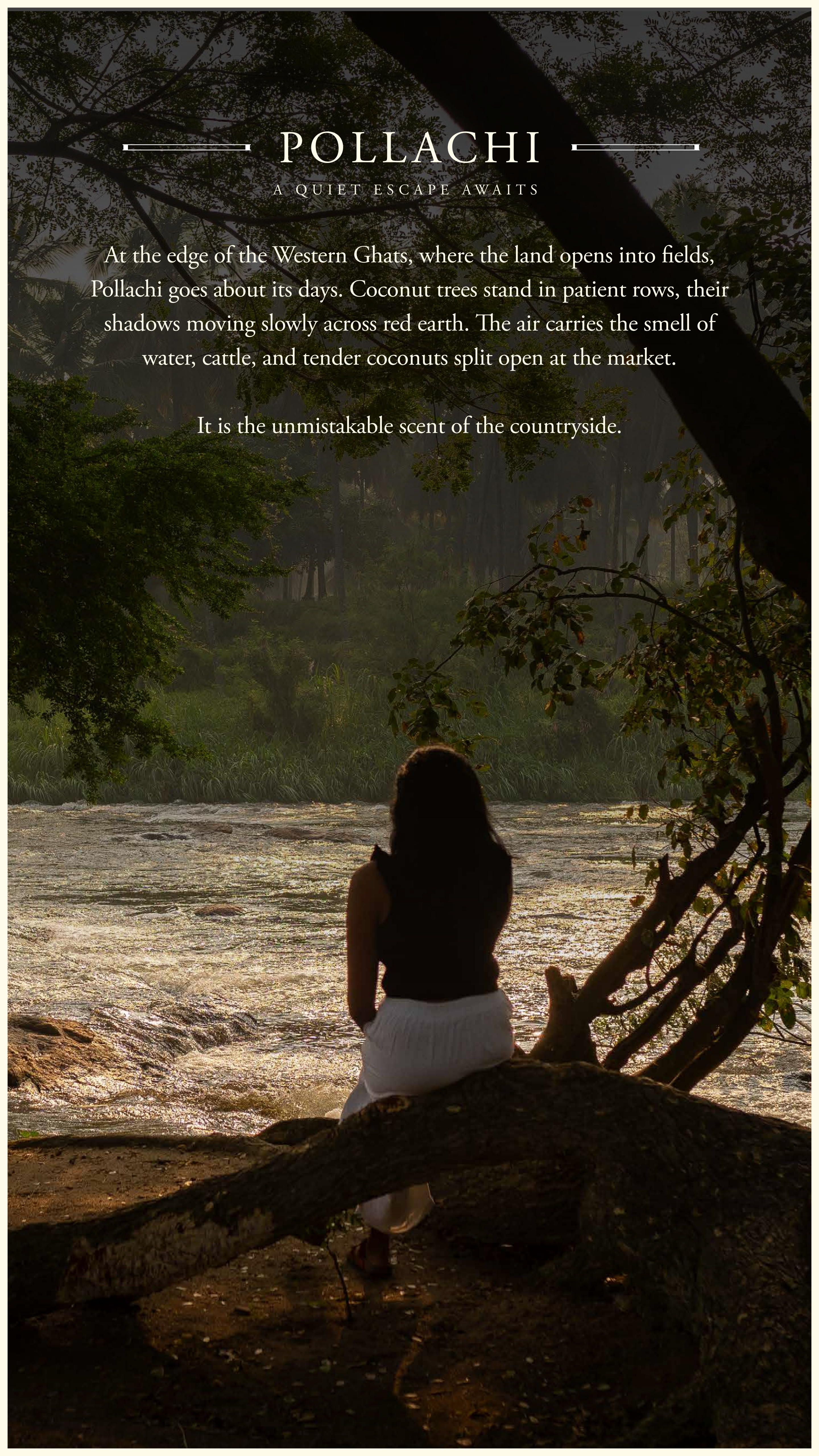

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A QUIET ESCAPE AWAITS

At the edge of the Western Ghats, where the land opens into fields, Pollachi goes about its days. Coconut trees stand in patient rows, their shadows moving slowly across red earth. The air carries the smell of water, cattle, and tender coconuts split open at the market.

It is the unmistakable scent of the countryside.





Every week, the Gandhi Market, one of the biggest in South India, wakes before dawn. Lorries and buses arrive, men call out prices, hands weigh vegetables, cattle shift their feet.

It is just another day in the life of Pollachi.

Derived from Pozhil Vaitchi, which translates to a land gifted with beauty, its simplicity is where Pollachi's true beauty lies.

The Anamalai Hills, also known as the Elephant Mountains, rise nearby, watching over the town. Monsoons nourish the land, and rivers run through it. Forests begin where the town ends, and plantations stretch quietly beyond sight. A filmmaker's delight, these landscapes have graced many a screen.

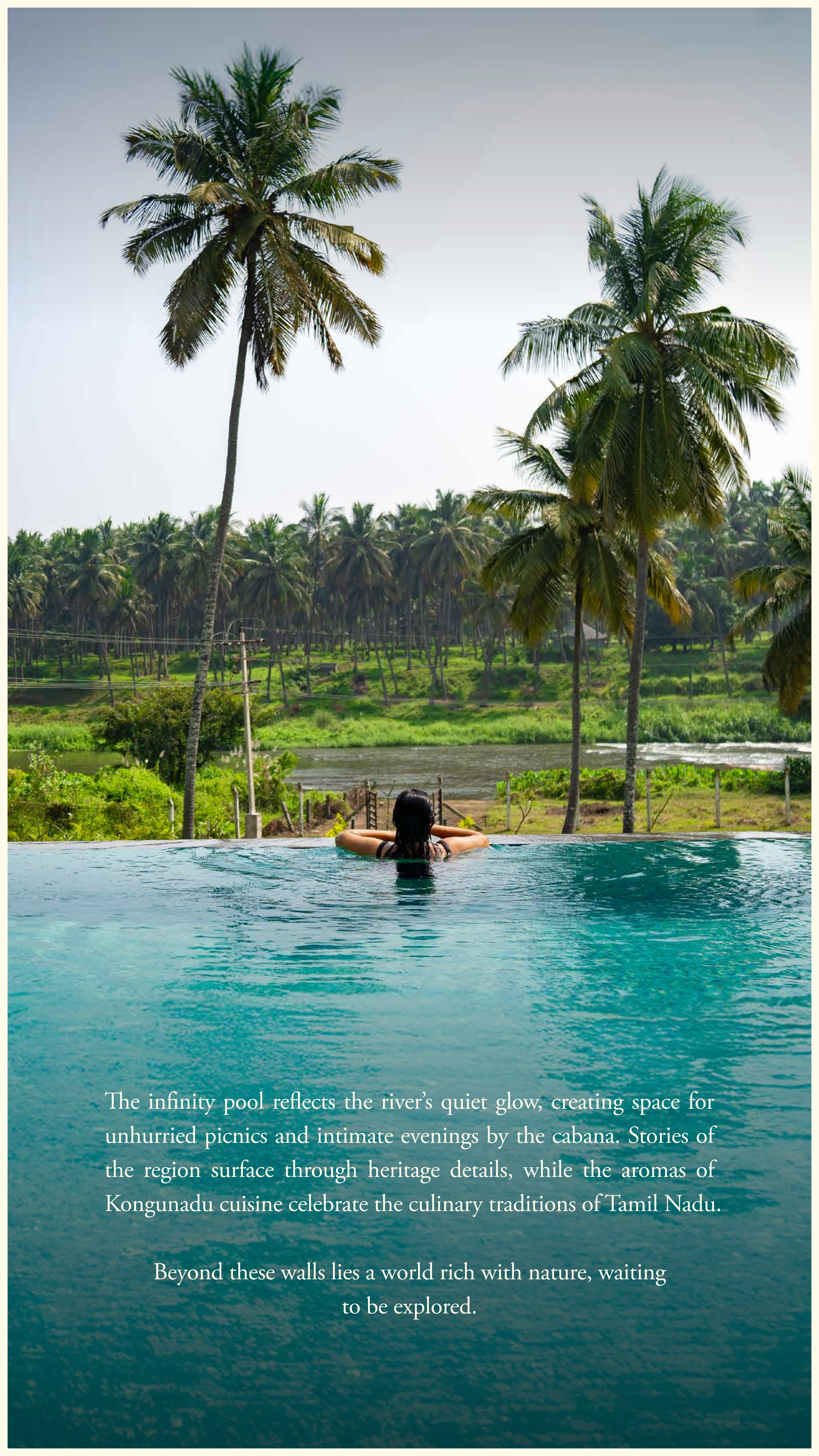
Pollachi is not a stopover.

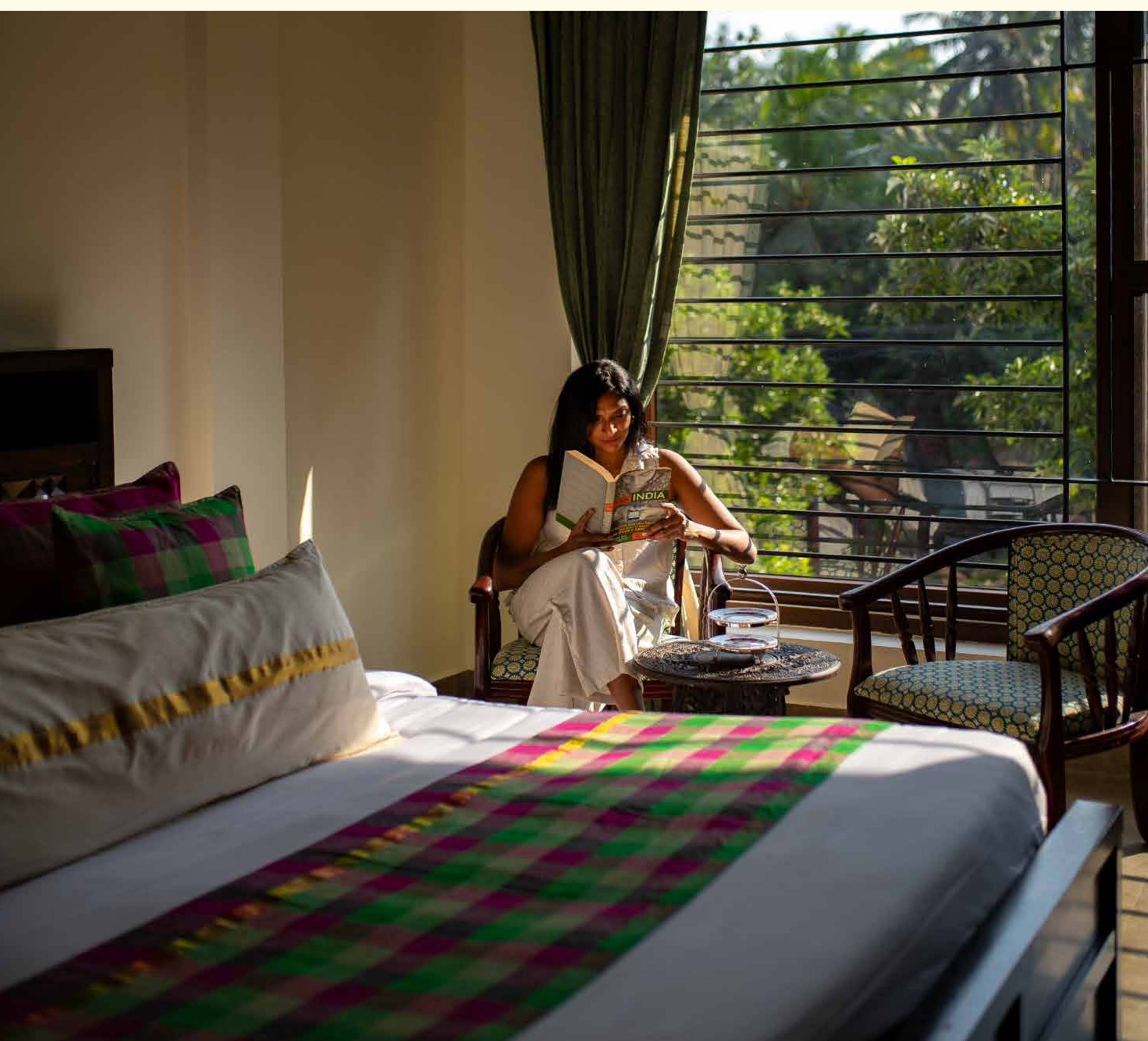
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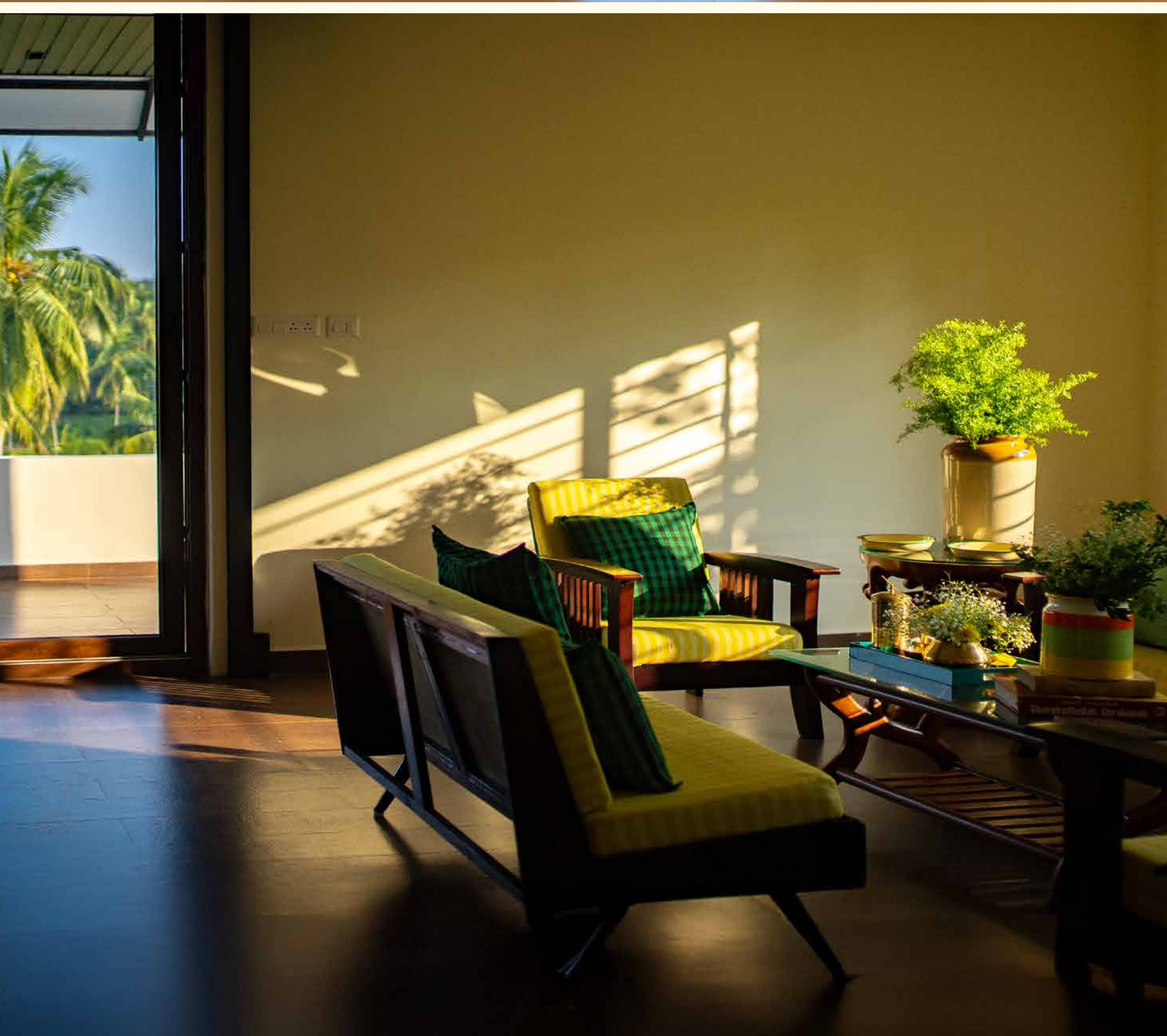
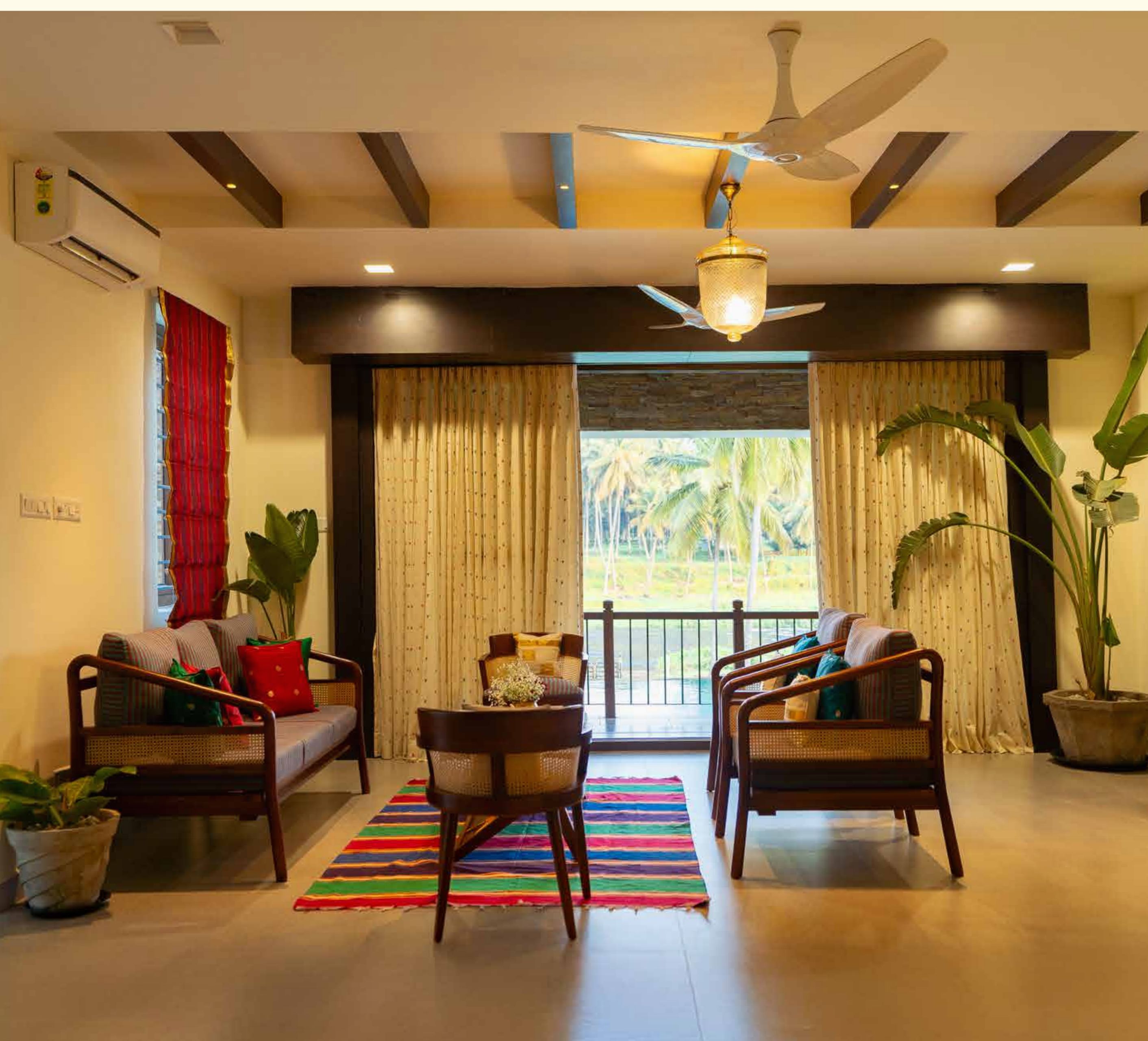
Set along the gentle flow of the river, Pollachi Riverhouse offers an escape shaped by nature and calm. The rustle of coconut trees and open skies set the tone for this expansive three-bedroom villa, where indoor and outdoor spaces flow seamlessly, and thoughtfully curated interiors bring in the essence of Tamil Nadu with warmth and ease.



The infinity pool reflects the river's quiet glow, creating space for unhurried picnics and intimate evenings by the cabana. Stories of the region surface through heritage details, while the aromas of Kongunadu cuisine celebrate the culinary traditions of Tamil Nadu.

Beyond these walls lies a world rich with nature, waiting to be explored.





A TASTE OF AUTHENTIC KONGUNADU CUISINE

The cuisine of Pollachi is predominantly Kongunadu, shaped by its location on the western edge of Tamil Nadu and influenced by neighbouring Kerala and Karnataka.

Food stays close to its source. Turmeric pulled from the soil. Coconuts broken open by hand. Millets that have nourished daily meals long before they were fashionable. Pulses, groundnuts and greens grown nearby, fish from local waters and country chicken raised close to home.

EXPERIENCE THE RHYTHMS OF POLLACHI

TREKKING | ANAMALAI TOPSLIP VISIT

Enter the Anamalai Tiger Reserve at dawn with a forest ranger. Walk through teak and sandalwood groves alive with bird calls, spotting elephant tracks and deer trails along the way.

As the trail rises, bamboo gives way to grasslands and sweeping views of the Western Ghats.

Dress warmly and carry water and binoculars.

BIRDING

Led by a local naturalist, this guided walk explores forest edges and village paths around Sethumadai. The mix of scrub, canals, and coconut groves attracts rich birdlife, especially in the early mornings and winter months. Wildlife sightings may include deer, gaur, elephants, and occasionally jungle cats.

Carry a pair of binoculars and water before you head out.

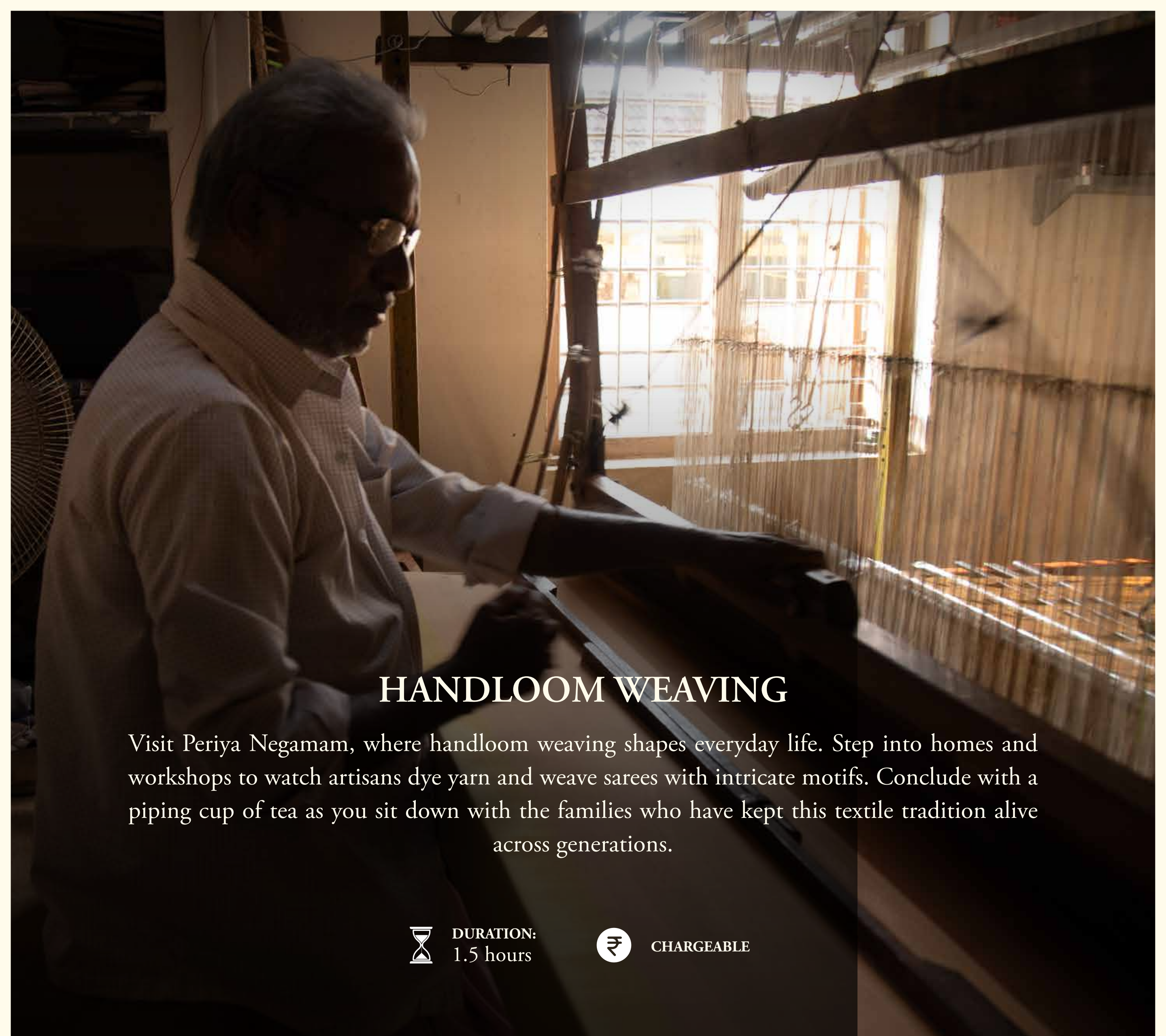

HANDLOOM WEAVING

Visit Periya Negamam, where handloom weaving shapes everyday life. Step into homes and workshops to watch artisans dye yarn and weave sarees with intricate motifs. Conclude with a piping cup of tea as you sit down with the families who have kept this textile tradition alive across generations.

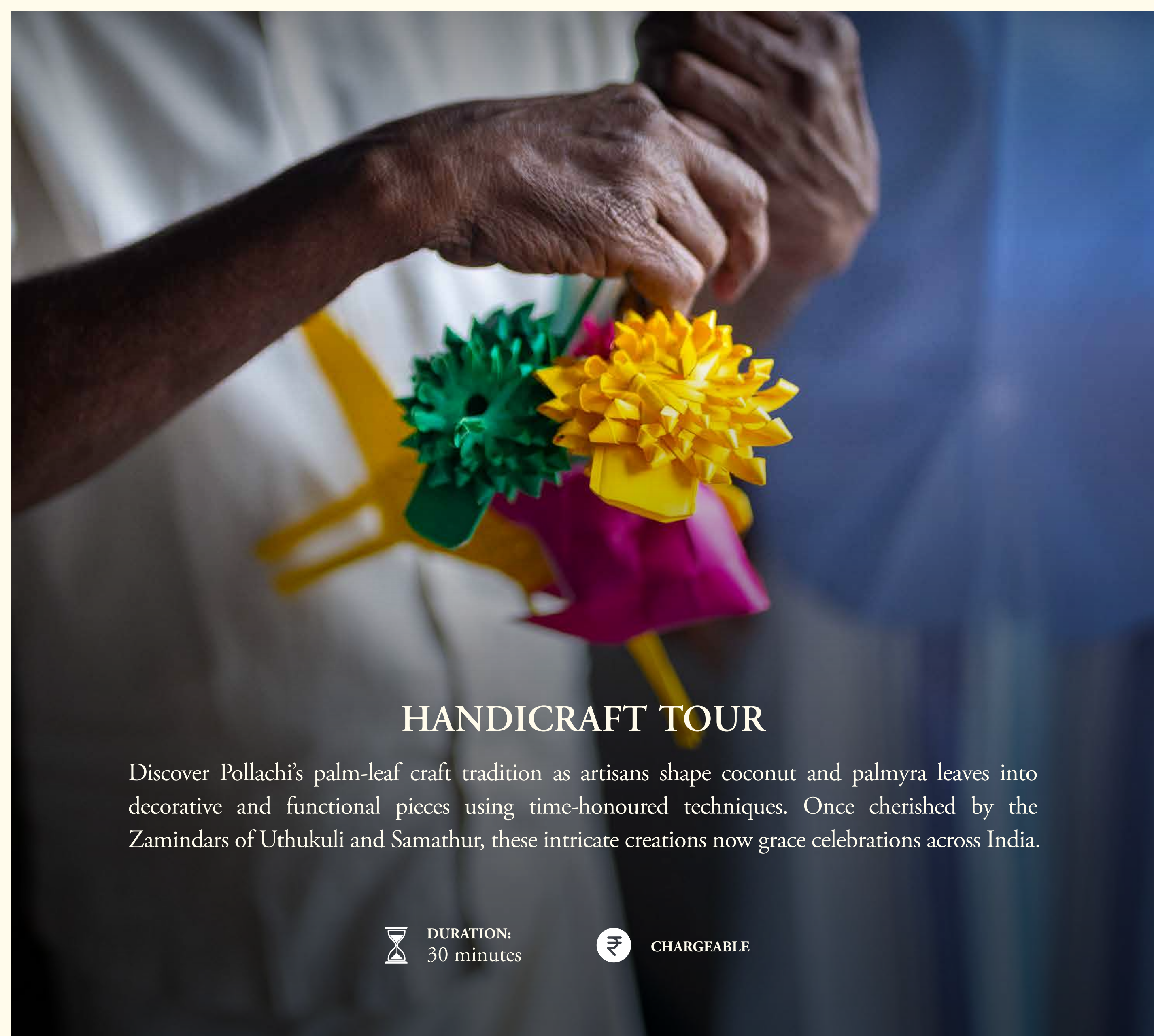

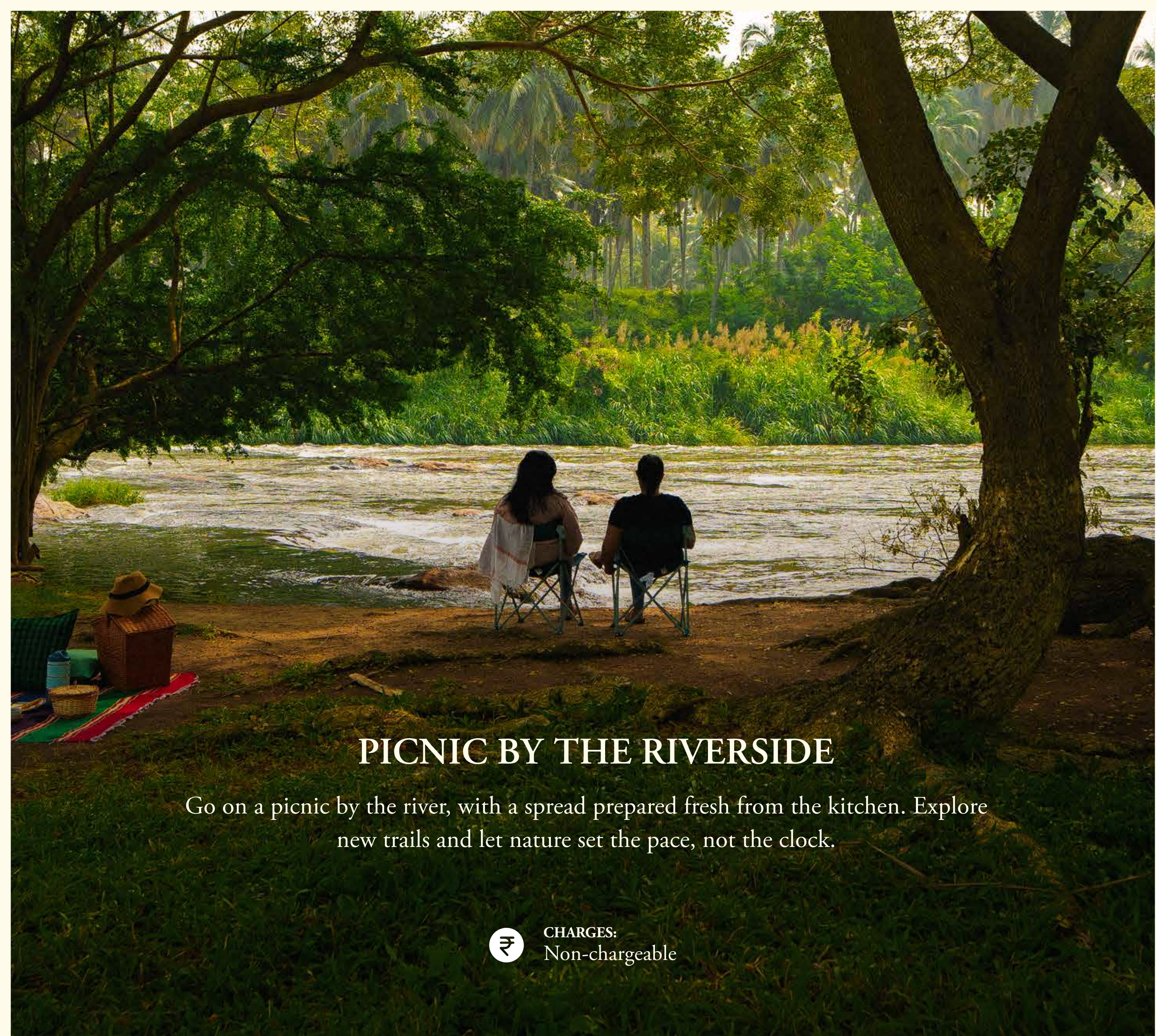


PALM JAGGERY MAKING

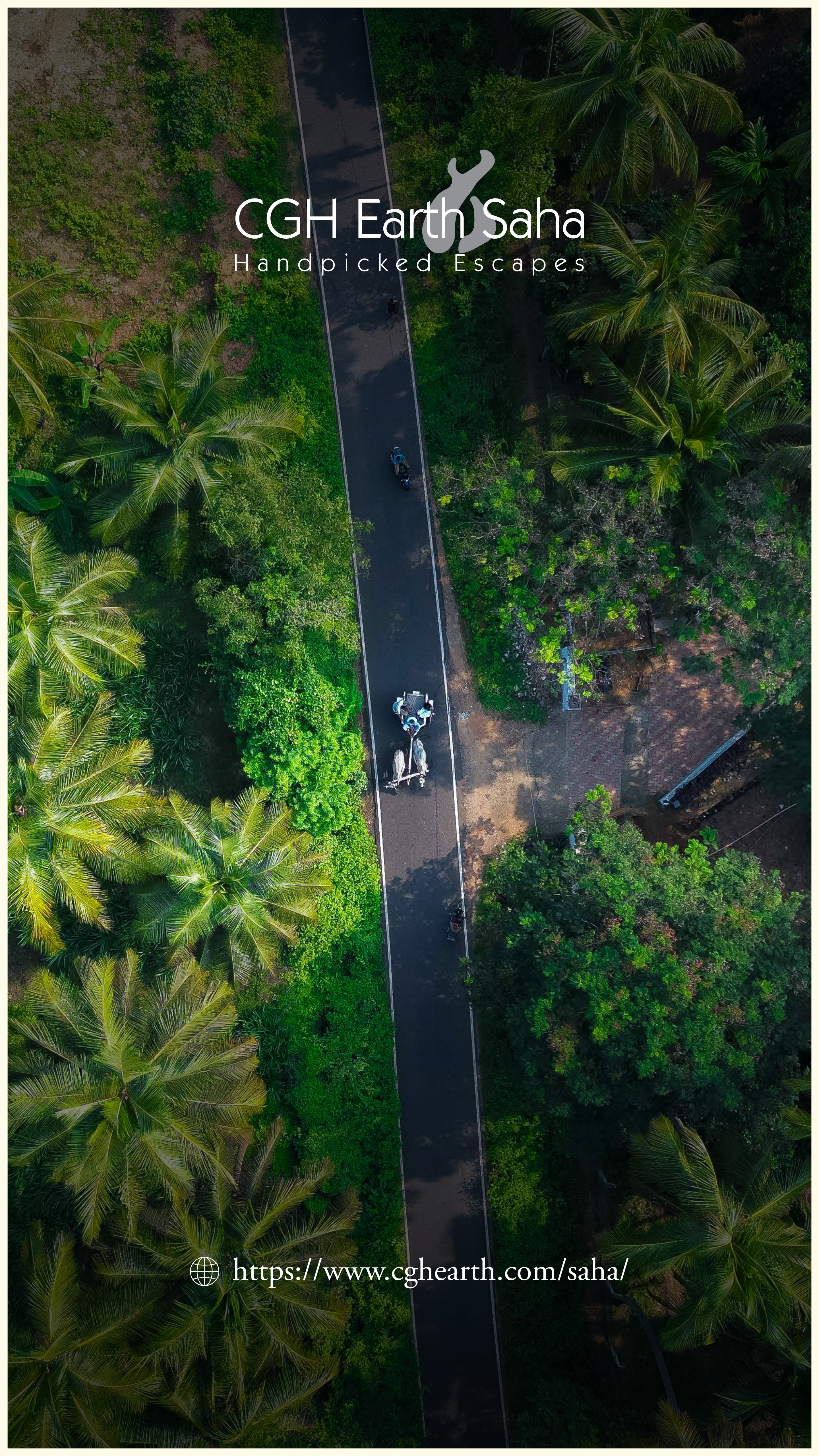
